

Visit of Didier Chaudesaygues to the Russian university of traditional art crafts

On September 18, 2025, the institute of traditional applied arts and Fedoskino institute of lacquer miniature painting hosted Didier Chaudesaygues, deputy secretary general of the Assembly of peoples of Eurasia and president of the Russia-France economic chamber (France). Didier Chaudesaygues familiarized himself with the specifics of the educational process at the institutes and visited museums of the branches where he was shown the diversity of traditional arts crafts of Russia: artistic embroidery, artistic lace making, artistic fabric painting, jewelry art, Bogorodskoye wood carving, bone-carving art, Fedoskino lacquer miniature painting, Rostov enamel.

At the institute of traditional applied arts, the guest witnessed a fashion show presenting the best graduation qualification projects of students – clothes decorated with artistic embroidery and works of artistic lace making.

During a business meeting between the president of Russian university of traditional art crafts (RUTAC), academician of the Russian academy of education, doctor of pedagogical sciences, professor V.F. Maksimovich and D. Chaudesaygues, opportunities and prospects for joint projects in the field of traditional art crafts development were discussed. It should be noted that over the past two years alone, RUTAC has organized three large exhibitions titled "Splendor of Russia's artistic heritage" in France – at UNESCO Headquarters and at the Russian house of science and culture in Paris.
